#### Public Health- Dayton & Montgomery County Immunization Clinic

Public Health - Dayton & Montgomery County Immunization Clinic provides routine vaccines for infants, children, teens, and adults. The clinic offers routinely recommended childhood vaccines as well as immunizations for school/college entry, employment, infectious disease exposure, and annual influenza.

Routine vaccines for eligible children, birth through 18 years of age, are provided at no cost through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program. Vaccines not provided under the VFC program (or for those not eligible) are provided by Public Health at the lowest possible cost. No eligible child will be turned away due to inability to pay. We bill all government and private insurances. For more information on eligibility and pricing, call our office at (937) 225-4550.

The clinic also provides vaccines for international travel by appointment. We recommend that the client schedule an appointment at the clinic at least 4-6 weeks before travel. Counseling regarding travel vaccine recommendations will be done by the nurse during the scheduled visit. Travelers can obtain information specific to their destinations by referring to the CDC Travel website at <https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel/destinations/list/>.

The Immunization Clinic is located on the 5<sup>th</sup> floor of the Reibold Building in downtown Dayton on 117 S. Main Street. There is a parking garage adjacent to the facility and it is within walking distance of the RTA bus hub. Clinic hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The clinic is closed daily from 11:30-12:30 p.m. and the second and fourth Friday of every month from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. All clinic services are provided by appointment. Please note that **we no longer have Outreach Clinics**. To avoid any confusion, please discard any Immunization Outreach schedules that you may have in your clinics. All patients are to be referred to the clinic at the Reibold Building.

When referring your patients or students to the Immunization Clinic, please instruct them to call 937-225-4550 to schedule an appointment. Please be sure that the parent or guardian has the most recent shot record from your office (or school). **We must have the child's shot record and insurance card at every visit.**
