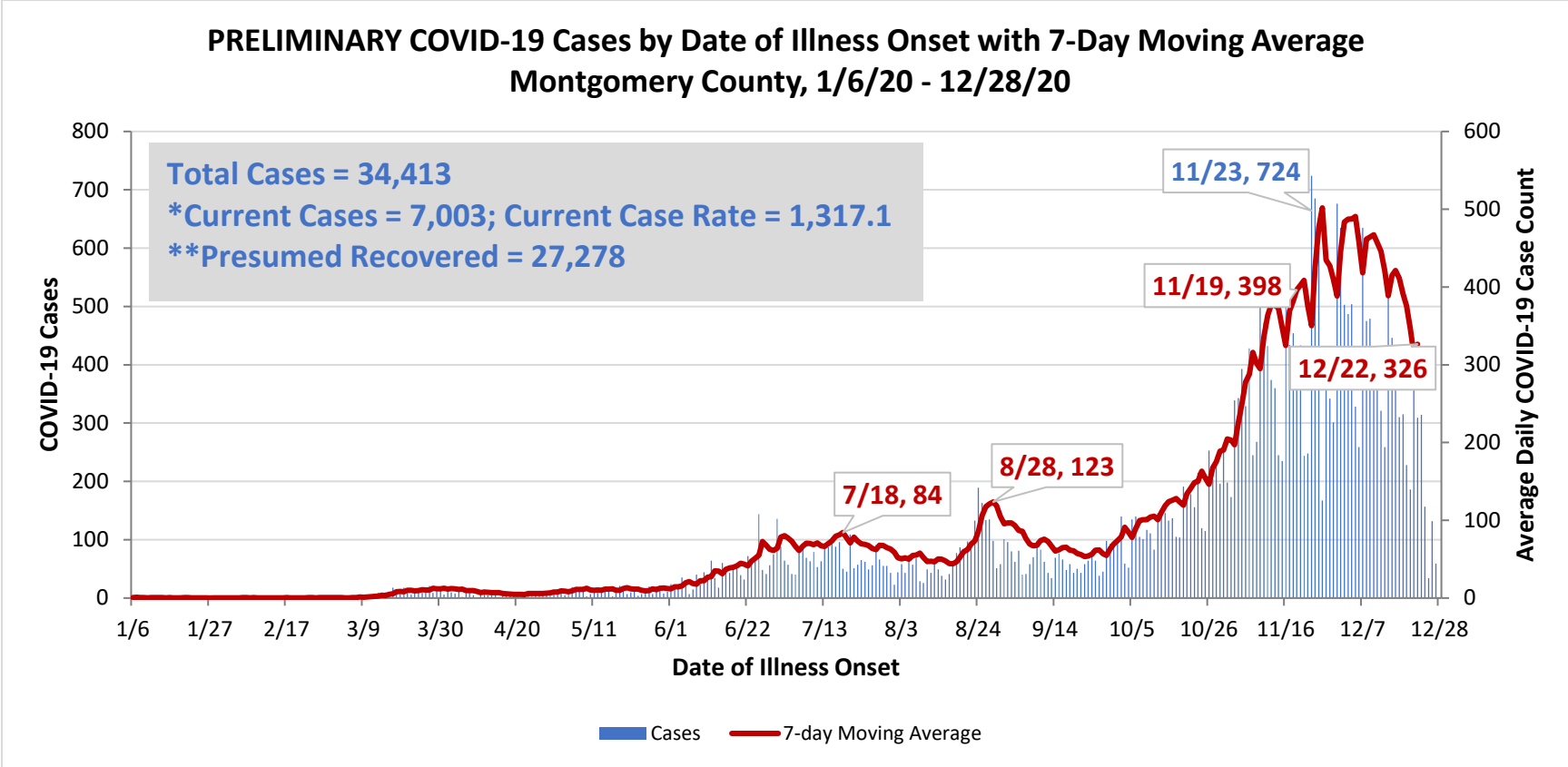


**Montgomery County COVID-19 Cases As of 12/28/20**

**Key Points:**

- Montgomery County’s average daily COVID-19 case count was the second highest it has been on 12/5/20 (491 cases per day).
- The highest incidence in reported COVID-19 cases occurred on 11/23/20 (724 cases).
- **The current case decreased 15% compared to last week (from 1,553 to 1317 cases per 100,000).**

**Montgomery County COVID-19 Outbreak and School Data:**

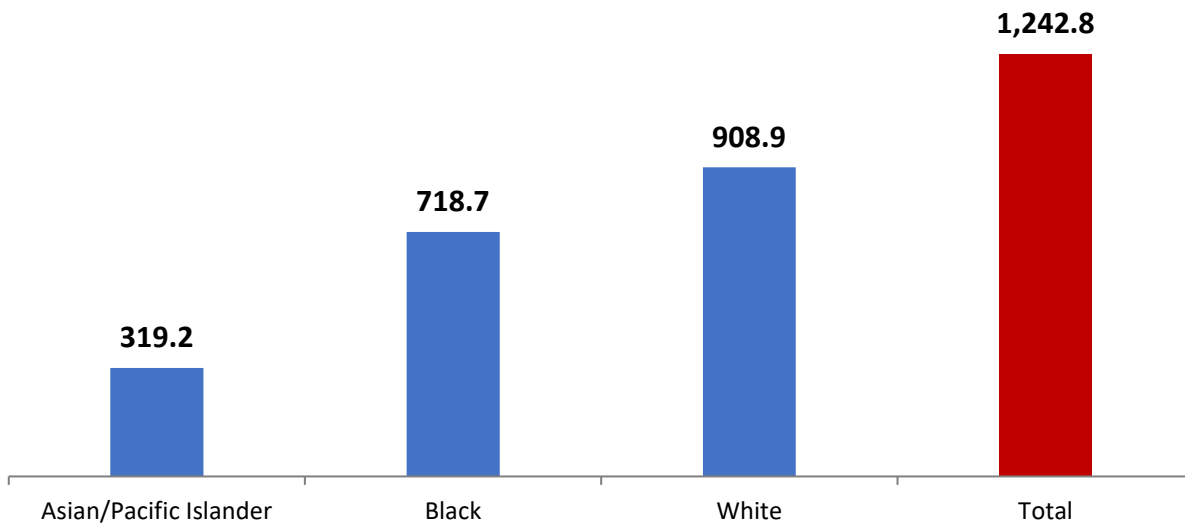
- Montgomery County currently has 110 COVID-19 outbreak investigations open at various long-term care facilities, businesses, and schools.
- Twenty (20) outbreak investigations have opened in the past three weeks – 10 (50%) long-term care facilities, 3 (30%) schools, 2 (10%) healthcare/treatment facilities, 2 (20%) homeless shelters, 1 (5%) fire department, 1 (5%) correctional institution, 1 (5%) business, and 1 (5%) court.
- **The current case rate decreased 16% from last week (from 1,487 to 1,243 cases per 100,000).**
- Montgomery County has a total of 1,349 cases associated with schools (764 students, 585 staff). Of the 1,349 cases, 12% (158 cases – 102 students, 56 staff) were reported in the past week – a **78% increase in reported cases compared to last week.**

**Current COVID-19 Case Rate by Race As of 12/27/20**



**Key Points:**

- Whites have the highest current case rate (908.9) and the highest number of current cases (3,586 cases).
- Blacks have the highest overall case rate (5,065.8).
- Race is unknown for 21% of total cases and 24% of current cases.

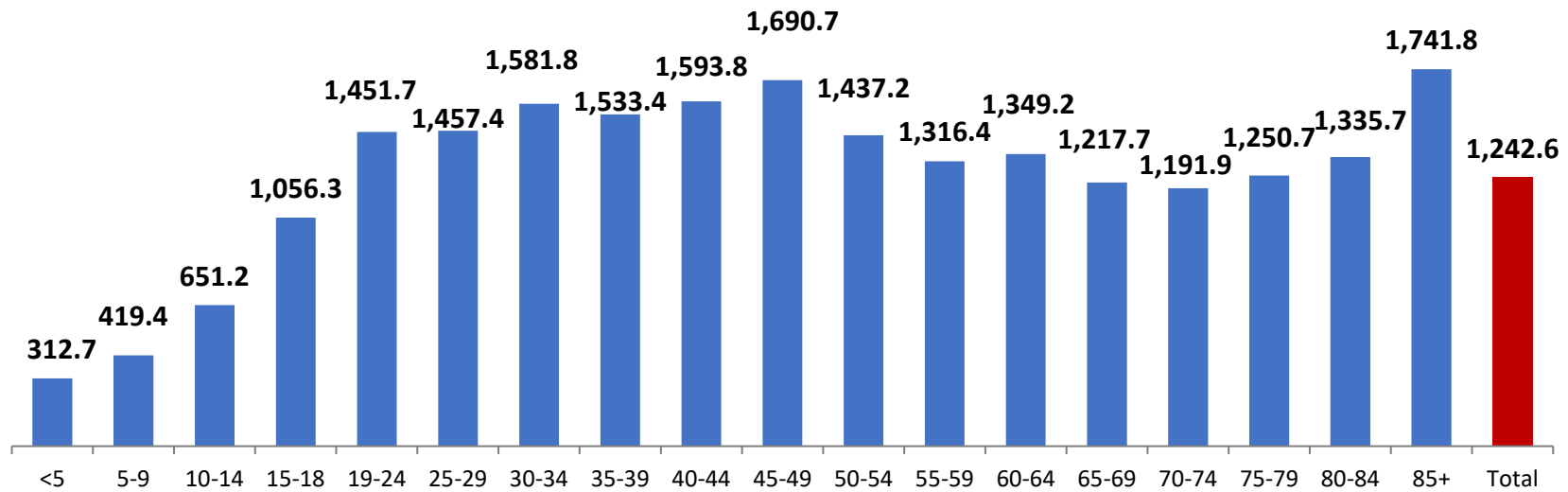

**Key Points:**

- The age group 85 years and older has the highest current case rate in Montgomery County (1,741.8), but the highest overall rate is among 19-24-year-olds (9,655.5).
- The highest number and percentage of hospitalizations occurred among 70-79-year-olds (702 hospitalizations; 24% of hospitalizations).
- Individuals 80 years and older account for less than 6% of total cases but 42% of total deaths due to COVID-19.
