



## Montgomery County COVID-19 Summary as of 4/9/2021

### Overall:

- **The current case rate (per 100,000) increased 20% in the last week (from 187 on 4/2/21 to 224 on 4/9/21).**
- **Montgomery County's average daily COVID-19 case count has increased 5% in the past week (from 61 cases per day on 3/26/21 to 64 cases per day on 4/2/21).**

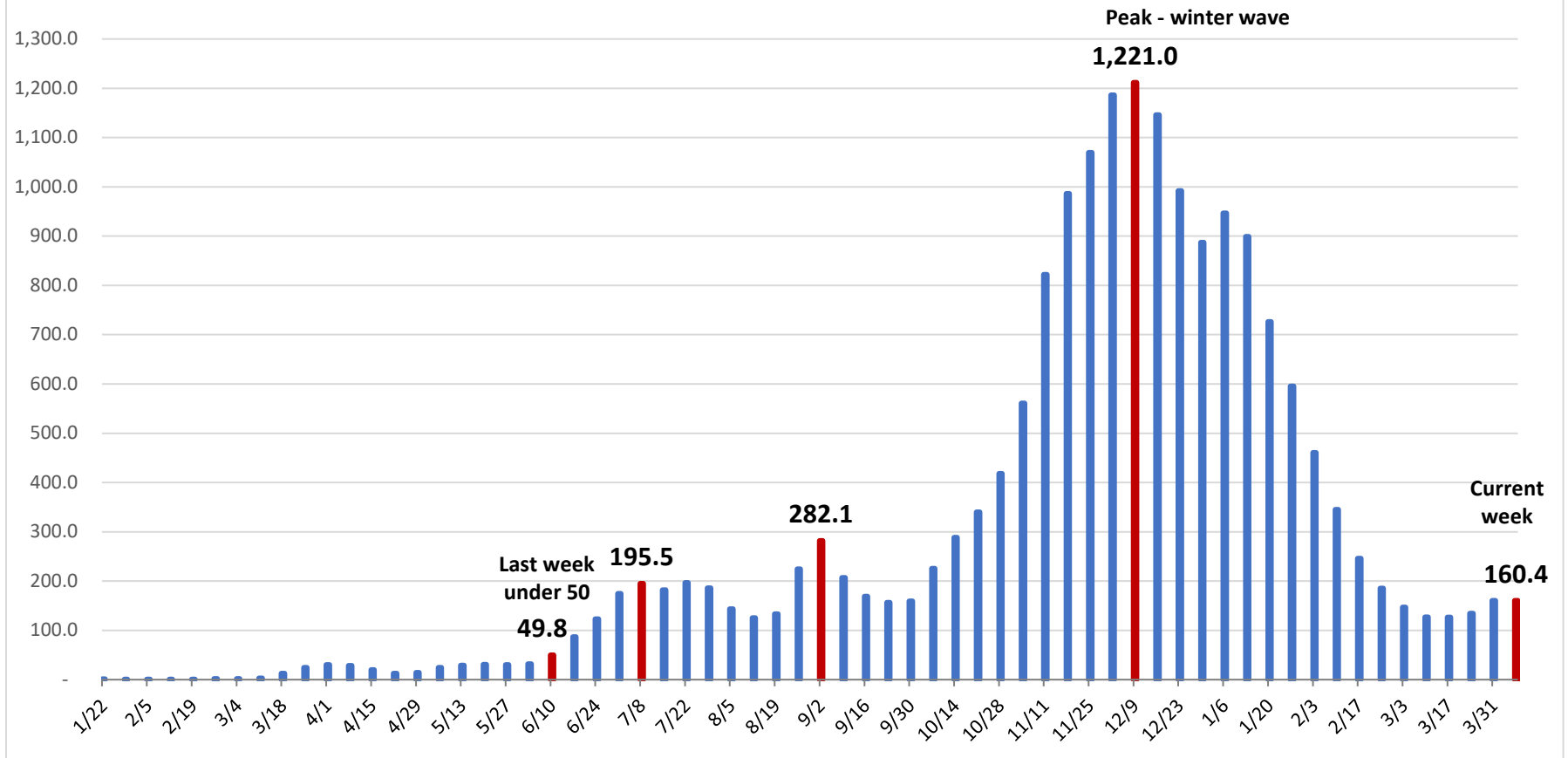
### Montgomery County COVID-19 Outbreak and School Data:

- Montgomery County currently has 198 COVID-19 outbreak investigations open at various long-term care facilities, businesses, and schools.
- **Zero outbreak investigations opened in the past week.**
- Montgomery County has a total of 2,357 cases associated with schools (1,424 students, 933 staff). **Of the 2,357 cases, 1.2% (28 cases – 22 students, 6 staff) were reported in the past week, an 18% decrease from last week.**

### Demographics:

- Blacks/African Americans have the highest current case rate (228.3) and the second highest number of current cases (276) – **a 32% increase from last week (172.9; 209)**. Whites have the second highest current case rate (165.3) and the highest number of current cases (652 cases), **a 13% increase in the last week (146.2; 577)**.
- Whites have the highest overall rate (7,350.1).
- **Current cases have increased by 19% in the last week (from 942 on 4/1/21 to 1,118 on 4/8/21).**
- **Race is unknown for 16% of total cases and 10% of current cases.**
- The age group 19-24 years has the highest current case rate (434.8).
- Individuals 70 years and older account for 13% of total cases, 44% of total hospitalizations, and 77% of total deaths.

- The two-week incidence rate of cases (160.4) has increased by 25% in the past month (from 127.0 on 3/10).
