



Montgomery County COVID-19 Summary as of 7/9/2021

Overall:

- The current case rate (per 100,000) remained the same in the last week (**31** on 7/1/21 and 7/8/21).
- Montgomery County's average daily COVID-19 case count remained the same in the last week (at **8** cases per day on 7/2/21 and 7/9/21). **Note:** case count is not available for 7/8; therefore, the average daily case count may change as new data is received.

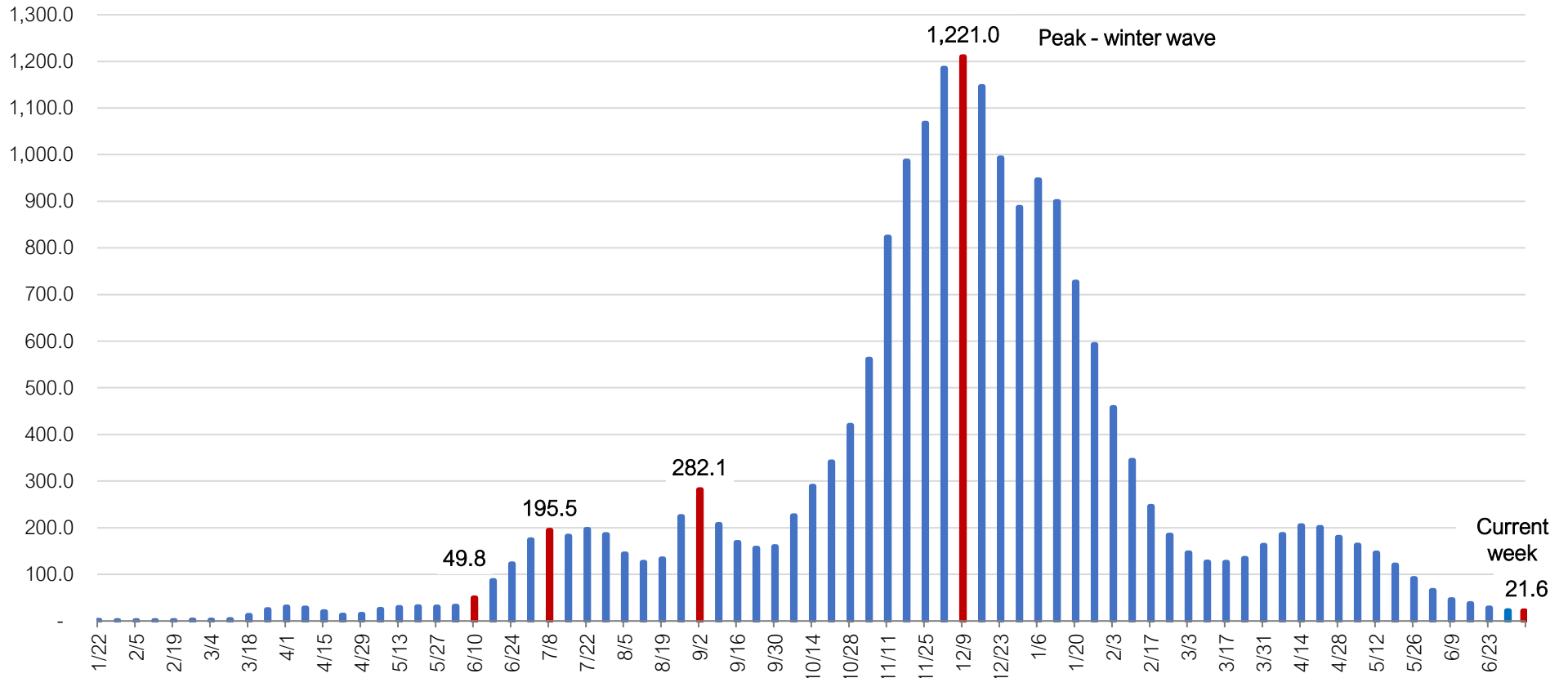
Montgomery County COVID-19 Outbreak and School Data:

- Montgomery County currently has **8** COVID-19 outbreak investigations open at various long-term care facilities, businesses, schools, and correctional institutions.
- Zero outbreak investigations opened in the past week and **6** investigations closed.
- Montgomery County has a total of 2,732 cases associated with schools (1,752 students, 980 staff). Of the 2,732 cases, **2** cases were reported in the last week (1 staff and 1 student).

Demographics:

- Current case rates remained the same for Asian/PIs (14.2) and Blacks (23.2), but **decreased** among Whites in the last week.
- Whites have the **highest** current case rate (26.6) – a **decrease** (by 5%) from 27.9 in the last week - and the **highest** number of current cases (105) – a **decrease** (by 5%) from 110 in the last week.
- Blacks/African Americans have the second highest current case rate (23.2) – which remained the same in the last week – and the second highest number of current cases (28) – which also remained the same in the last week.
- Hispanics (8,598.8) have the **highest** overall rate, followed by Blacks/African Americans (8,216.8).
- Current cases have **decreased** by 1% in the last week (from 165 on 7/1/21 to 164 on 7/8/21).
- Race is unknown for 16% of total cases and 12% of current cases.
- The age group 35-39 years has the **highest** current case rate (55.8).
- Individuals 70 years and older account for 12% of total cases, 42% of total hospitalizations, and 76% of total deaths.

- The two-week incidence rate of cases (21.6) **decreased** by 2% in the past week (from 22.0 on 6/23) and is the lowest since 5/6/2020 (24.6).
- The two-week incidence rate of cases has **decreased** (by 90%) since 4/14/2021 (from 204.3 to 21.6)

Note: Two-week incidence rates may slightly change based on new and/or updated daily case counts received from the Ohio Department of Health.
