



## COVID-19 Weekly Summary Montgomery County, As of 7/30/2021

### Current COVID-19 Cases – symptom onset within the last 21 days:

- In the last week, current COVID-19 cases **increased** (by 65%) from 517 to 852
- Blacks have the highest current case rate (**240.7**) followed by Whites (**108.7**)
- Whites have the highest current case count (**429**) followed by Blacks (**291**).
- Individuals 25 to 29yrs have the **highest** current case rate (299.8 per 100,000)

### Overall COVID-19 Cases:

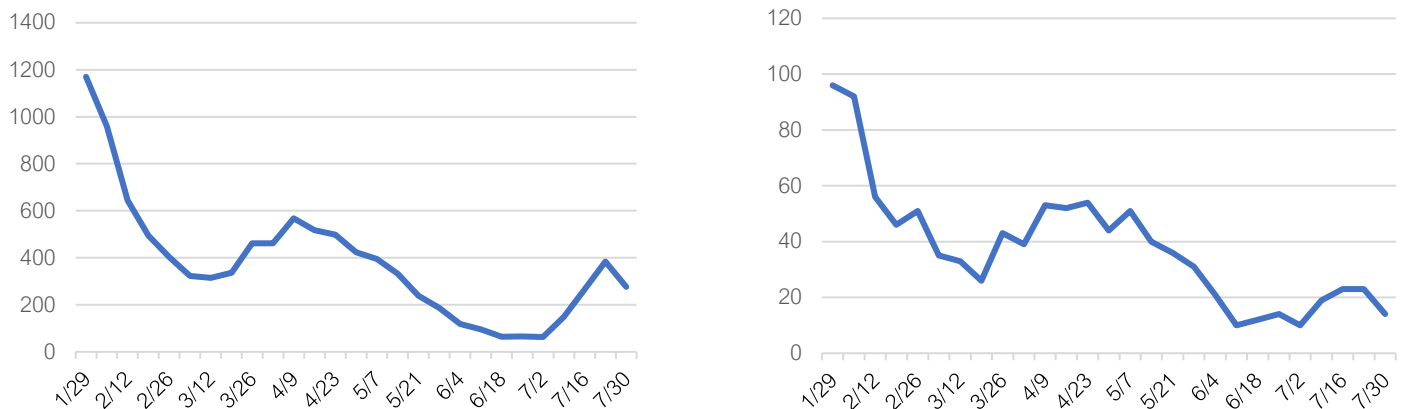
- During the month of July, the number of reported COVID-19 cases **increased** each week
- During the month of July, the 7-day average daily case count **increased** (by 455%) from 9 to 50
- During the month of July, the number of reported COVID-19 hospitalizations (89) **increased** (by 56%) from 57 hospitalizations in June
- There were **zero** COVID-19 deaths reported
- Individuals 70 years and older account for **12%** of total cases, **42%** of total hospitalizations, and **76%** of total deaths

**Figure 2. Weekly COVID-19 Cases and Hospitalizations, Montgomery, as of 7/30/2021\***

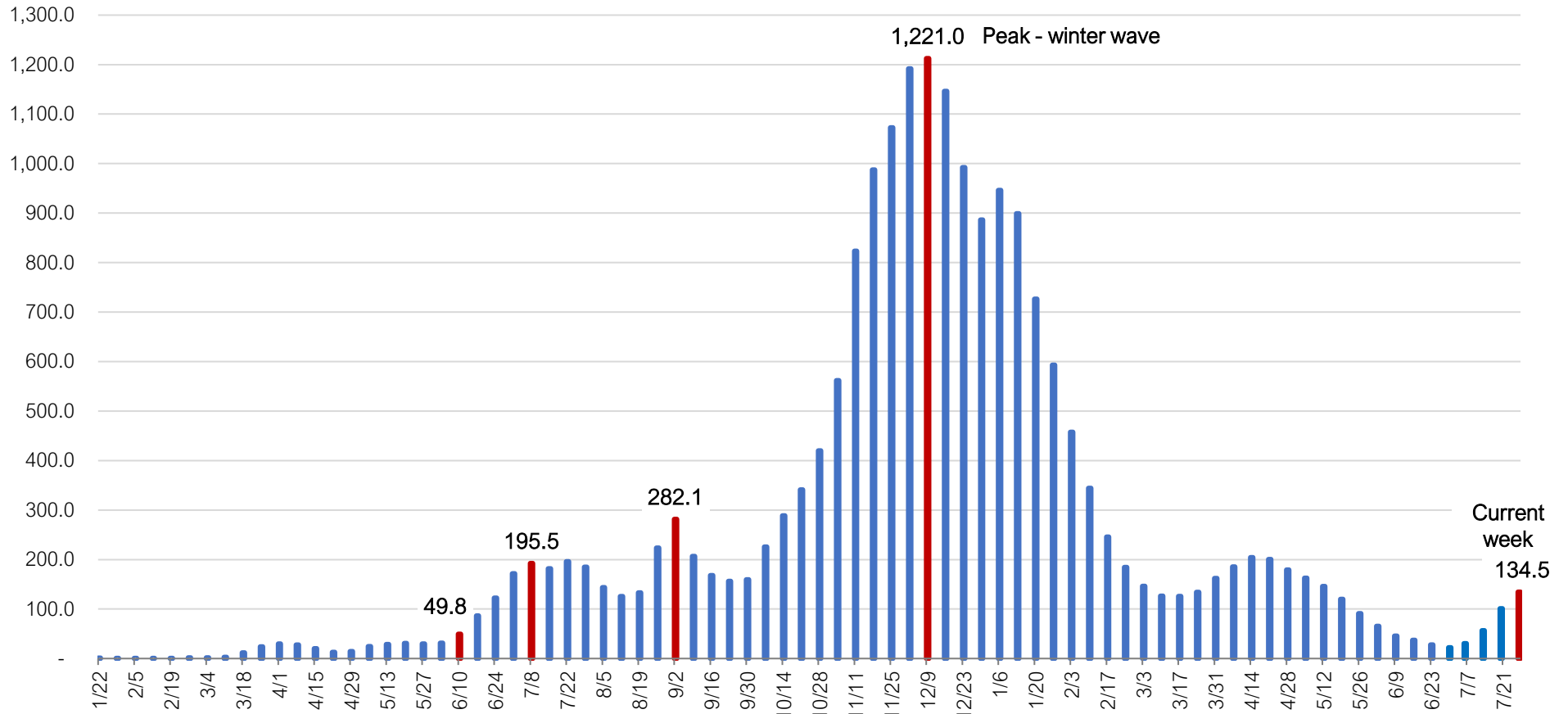

## Overall COVID-19 Case Rate:

- Hispanics (8760.4) and Blacks (8669.3) have the **highest** overall COVID-19 case rates
- The two-week incident rate of cases **increased** (by 25%) from 101 per 100,000 last week to 134.5
- The two-week incident rate of cases (134.5 per 100,000) is 6 times higher compared to June 30<sup>th</sup> (22.2)
- The two-week incident rate of cases increased each week during the month of July

Figure 2. Two-Week COVID-19 Case Rate per 100,000 Residents, Montgomery, as of 7/30/2021

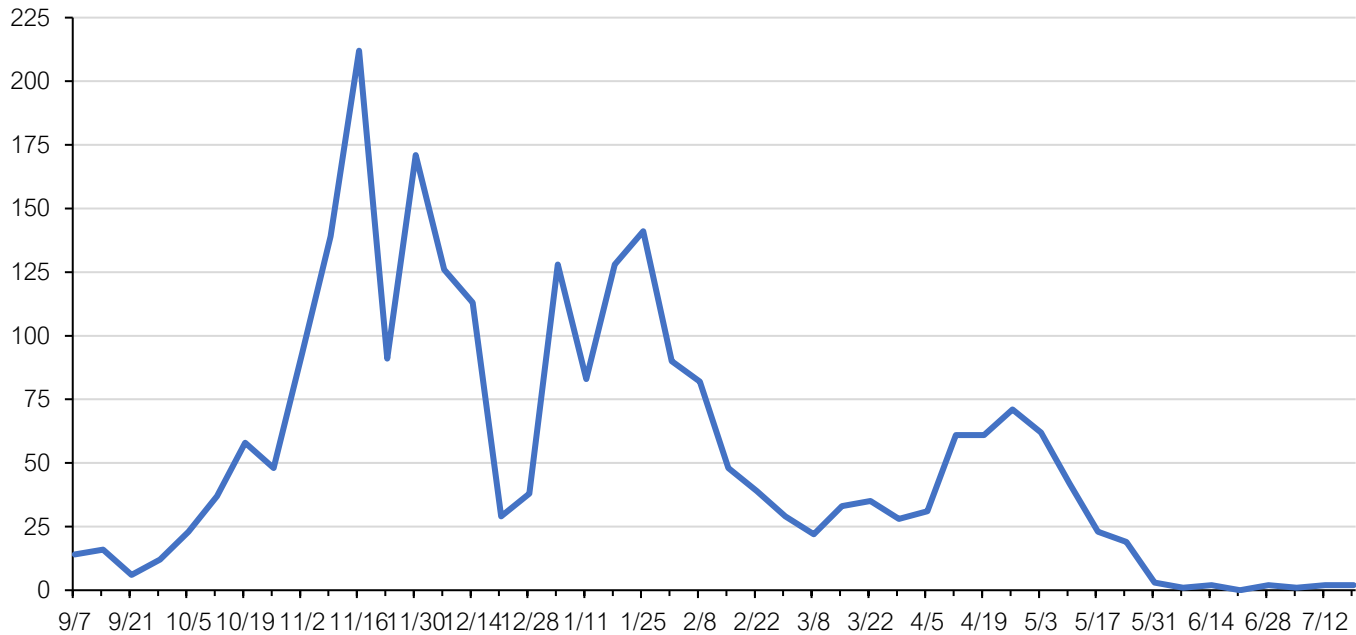

## K-12 School Cases:

- Montgomery County has a total of **2,737** COVID-19 cases associated with schools – students account for most cases (1,753 students, 984 staff)
- There were **2** cases reported in the last week (1 staff, 1 student)
- K-12 cases have **declined** since April 2021
- To date, there are only **5** cases reported in July

## COVID-19 Outbreaks:

- Montgomery County has had **289** COVID-19 outbreaks with **10,308** confirmed and probable cases
- Outbreak cases account for **19%** of all Montgomery County COVID-19 cases (10,308 of 53,802)
- Most outbreaks (**25%** or **71**) occurred within long-term care facilities, followed by business sites (**15%** or **42**)
- Montgomery County has **11** COVID-19 outbreak investigations open at various long-term care facilities, correctional institutes, a business site, a childcare center, and a non-profit organization
- There were **3** outbreak investigations opened and **1** investigation closed in the past week
